Easy Baby Booties Using HDC

Pictured is a double fingering yarn using size “F”

Crochet Abbreviations

SC	single crochet	REP	repeat
DC	double crochet	BEG	beginning
TOG	together	SK	skip
HDC	half double crochet	SL ST	slip stitch
*	Repeat # of times from *		



Materials: Crochet Hook Size
 “D” for Tiny “F” for Preemie “I” for Infant
 Yarn for Preemie - Fingering or Baby Yarns
 Yarn for Infant - Baby Yarns or Sport weight
 1 yard small Ribbon for TIES (Although yarn can be used as well)

Row 1	CH 10; 3HDCs in 3 rd CH from hook; then HDC6, 5HDCs in last ST; then coming back around... HDC6, then 2HDCs in next ST. SL TOG row.
Row 2	CH2, HDC in same ST, 2HDCs in next 2 STs; HDC6, 2HDCs in each of the next 5 STs; HDC6, then 2HDCs in next TWO STs. SL TOG row.
Row 3	Small Booties... In outside loops. CH3; DC around Row. SL TOG row. Large Booties... In outside loops. CH2; HDC around row. SL TOG row. CH2; HDC around row. SL TOG row.
Row 4	CH2, SC11, Next 8 STs (DC to DEC by 4), SC to end. SL TOG row.
Row 5	CH2, SC9, Next 8 STs (DC to DEC by 4), SC to end. SL TOG row.
RibbonRow	CH4, SK1, * DC1, CH1, SK1; Repeat from * to end. SL TOG row.
Row 7	CH2, * SC2 through next CH1 space; Repeat from * to end. SL TOG row.

Weave the ribbon through Ribbon Row.

Hints and Tricks: You can use this basic bootie to work with any outfit. Just add on the Outfit’s Trim after Row 7 and it will match perfectly...
